

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING LOW BID FOR SIDEWALK ENHANCEMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HAMILTON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SUCH IMPROVEMENTS WITH MS CONTRACTING, LLC FOR SUCH WORK

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS TO WIT:

SECTION 1: The City accepts as the lowest and best bid for the Sidewalk Enhancement Project, Project TAP-9900 (116) the bid of MS Contracting, LLC, of Brookfield, Missouri, and the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Hamilton, Missouri are hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Hamilton, Missouri, to sign a contract for such work with the Contractor as prepared by the project engineer. The total bid was for \$96,531.50. The City part of the costs after application of the State Grant is \$34,581.50.


SECTION 2: This ordinance repeals any prior ordinance or parts of any prior ordinance that might be in conflict herewith.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.




