
SECTION 1: The Mayor and Clerk of the City of Hamilton, Missouri are hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Hamilton, Missouri, to sign the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof to employ Jean Kaup Van Iperen as City Administrator.


SECTION 2: This ordinance repeals any prior ordinance or parts of any prior ordinance that might be in conflict herewith.
