AN ORDINANCE SETTING RATES IN THE CITY OF HAMILTON, MISSOURI FOR SEWER SERVICE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS TO WIT:

SECTION 1. The rates for sewer service to customers of the sanitary sewer system of City of Hamilton, Missouri, shall be as set forth on Exhibit A. Pursuant to Section 67.042 RSMo a statement of costs for such rate increases is on file with the City Clerk, and the Board of Aldermen finds that such rate increases are necessary to support the funding of the sewer system of the City, including the payment of revenue bonds issued by the City.

SECTION 2: This ordinance repeals any prior ordinance or parts of any prior ordinance that might be in conflict herewith.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval with the rates to be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.

SECTION 4: That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Aldermen hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.
